USDAA courses will be published on my site by 10pm the night before

We will have a copy posted so that you can take a picture with your phone.

For UKI: Please ensure you understand the new criteria regarding dogs being measured. UKI Rule Book edition 10. If a dog is under 3 and newly registered, a temporary measure or proof of the dog's height must be done by the dog's 3rd trial. A permanent measure must be obtained by a UKI official measurer between 12-18 months after the dog's first/ temporary measure. Any registered dog that only has a temporary measure, must follow the above rule. If a newly registered dog is over 3, they must obtain a measure by an official UKI measurer by their 3rd trial and this measurement will be permanent. If you ask for a challenge measure when you have a permanent measure, you must state this when you are getting the dog measured so the correct protocol can be followed and you may not continue to challenge a measure when you have challenged it once.

For USDAA: ALL dogs not having a permanent card/printout from the USDAA website showing permanent status will need to be measured if you have not mailed a copy of the permanent card/printout in advance, or if your dog is NOT jumping Ch24" or P20". You may also email me a copy of your permanent card or printout and save the check-in hassle. You can take a picture of the card/printout with your phone and email it. You can also send me a copy of your AKC Permanent Height card if you have one. If you have a permanent UKI measurement, there will be an asterisk in the height category column of the My Dogs page. We will also need the second page after you click on Edit under the Actions column which shows the dog's actual height.

If you are relatively new to USDAA, you do need to print out the temporary measuring sheet from your dog's page on the USDAA site – it has all of your dog's information on it. You will need to get that sheet signed by the judge and then keep it until you have all the required measurements

Some site information:

If it is a very wet and muddy weekend, you will need to bring a clean pair of shoes to wear in the ring. No muddy shoes in the ring. Also, no muddy dog feet in the ring.

Indoor “real” bathrooms – please don’t bring your dogs inside with you 😊

Indoor crating is available. Use a tarp, plastic or mat underneath your crates or Xpens. Please consolidate crating as much as possible.

No grooming in the building.

Dog must be on leash at all times except when in the ring. Exercise and toilet your dog in the designated areas. Please poop and scoop and use garbage containers on the site. Be courteous to others using the area. No aggressive dogs.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Do not let your dogs on the neighbor's property. No dogs allowed in the front of the building by the pond area by the docking areas. Dogs must remain in the areas of the NORTH of the building. Signs will be posted accordingly.

Bitches in season are allowed and will run in their assigned spot in the run order EXCEPT for Advanced/P2 and Starters/P1 Standard where they will run at the end of the class. The BIS must wear well-fitting pants – no droopy drawers!!! The handler/owner acknowledges the inherent risk of running a dog on an agility course with BIS pants on and assumes all risk by doing so. Handler/owner will minimize walking the BIS around the grounds and will attempt to crate away from congested areas.

via I-76: Exit 2 (Seville). Go South 0.6 miles. Turn RIGHT onto W. Greenwich Rd for 0.6 miles. One Smart Dog is the driveway on your right after Ryan Rd. There is a railroad track at Ryan Rd. Via I-71: Take exit 209 to merge onto I-76 E/US-224 E toward Akron. Take Exit 2 to merge onto OH-3 S/Wooster Pike toward Seville. Go South 0.6 miles. Turn RIGHT onto W Greenwich Rd for 0.6 miles. One Smart Dog is the driveway on your right after Ryan Rd. When your rear tires are on the railroad track, you should immediately turn right into the One Smart Dog access road. You will see a large cream/gray warehouse set back from the road in front of you. Welcome to One Smart Dog!
