### **Statement of Authority of the Organizing Committee**

The Organizing Committee is the governing body for this event and shall be the sole authority on matters relative to conduct of the event.

### **Entries & Acceptance**

#### **General Rule on Eligibility**

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age, regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at [www.usdaa.com](http://www.usdaa.com).

#### **No Entry For Exhibition Only**

Entries For Exhibition Only will not be accepted. Should a dog be required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measure-in, it will be placed first in the running order at the higher height for all classes entered.

#### **Policy on Refusal of Entry**

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

#### **Refund Policy**

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

#### **Charges for NSF Check/Credit Card**

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution shall be assessed a \$40 service charge. Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

### **Policy Allowing Same-weekend Move-Ups**

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level with a 24-hour waiting period at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days are not allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse. Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the last class of the day on which you earn your title.

### **Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date**

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date. To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

### **Express & Overnight Entries**

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery without signature is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

### **Regional - Provisional GP/PGP/STP Entries**

Provisional entries will be accepted for competitors who have not earned a qualifying score prior to the closing date, which is required for entry to the Grand Prix, Performance Grand Prix or Steeplechase Regional classes. To compete in the class under the provisional entry, a qualifying score must be earned at a local tournament qualifying class for each respective tournament entered prior to the start of the Regional tournament class. A separate payment for provisional entry fees to the tournament classes is required and must be designated on the Entry Form, or such payment will be nonrefundable should the dog not be eligible to run.

### **General Entry Conditions**

#### **Statement of Responsibility**

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

#### **Policy on Fault Limits**

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

#### **Prohibitions on Aids & Devices**

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.

#### **Spam Blocker**

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

## **Check-in & Measuring**

### **Dog Measurements & Certification**

All dogs not jumping 26" in the Championship Program or 22" in the Performance Program must be measured unless they have a permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration card. When not enrolling electronically, please send a copy of one of the following items to facilitate the check-in process:

- photocopy of permanent dog registration card,
- printout of the dog-information page from your USDAA® competitor account, or
- copy of your check-in letter from USDAA indicating your temporary card has been accepted by the USDAA office and your permanent registration card is in process.

### **Check-In Times**

Thursday: Check In and Measuring from 11 to 11:45am

Friday: Check In and Measuring from 6:45 to 7:30am

Saturday and Sunday: Check In and Measuring from 7 to 7:45am

### **Regional - Special Measuring**

Competitors whose dog has a temporary height card **MUST** have the dog measured prior to checking in at any Regional Championship event or Cynosport® World Games in order to confirm that the dog is eligible for the height entered.

If the dog measures up, the competitor must jump the dog at the higher jump height in all classes regardless of the jump height in which the dog earned its qualifications. If the competitor had a bye at the lower height, the bye is forfeited, and the competitor must compete in all rounds that may have been bypassed as a result of the bye.

### **A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In**

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may opt to run the dog in the lower jump height class "For Exhibition Only", and no awards or qualifying scores may be earned. The competitor may not change their entry from one program to another (e.g., from Championship to Performance).

### **Team & Versatility Pairs Measure-up Policy - FEO**

The handler of a dog entered in Team or Versatility Pairs that is required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measurement must notify the secretary immediately. Should the higher jump height make the dog ineligible for their team (three jump heights), the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from available dogs. The dog may not be moved to Versatility Pairs.

In the event the competitor is unprepared to run their dog at the higher jump height, they may run in the tournament For Exhibition Only. No member of the Team or Pair may earn a tournament qualification, but Team or Pairs partners are eligible for individual placements, tournament top ten points and Lifetime Achievement Qs in the individual tournament classes.

## **Class Descriptions**

### **Titling Class Rules & Descriptions**

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from [www.usdaa.com/rulesReg\\_eBook.cfm](http://www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm), and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from [www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm](http://www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm), each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

### **Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions**

## **Prizes & Awards**

### **Titling Classes**

Ribbons for 1st through 4th place will be awarded in each jump height (and for mini and open in pairs). Maroon qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score in any non-tournament classes.

Title rosettes will also be available.

### **Tournaments**

#### Grand Prix/Performance Grand Prix

Round 1: maroon & white ribbons (GP) or maroon & pink ribbons (PGP) will be awarded to all competitors earning a qualifying score of zero faults.

Round 2: maroon & white rosettes (GP) or maroon & pink rosettes (PGP) will be awarded to all competitors having zero faults and earning a bye (top 50% in each jump height) into the semifinals at the Cynosport World Games. 1st through 3rd place in each jump height will receive a rosette. The first place competitor in each jump height shall be named the Regional Champion and will receive a trophy.

#### Steeplechase

Round 2: maroon, gold and green semifinalist rosettes will be awarded to competitors earning a bye into the semifinals at the Cynosport World Games. Prize money will be awarded in accordance with tournament rules. 1st - 3rd placement rosettes.

#### Performance Speed Jumping

Round 2: prize money will be awarded in accordance with tournament rules. 1st - 3rd placement rosettes

#### Team & Versatility Pairs

Overall: Each member of the first place team/pair will receive a plaque.

Each member of the first through third place teams/pairs will receive medallions.

Members of all qualifying teams/pairs will receive lapel pins.

### **Site Information**

**Exercise Arenas:** There will be two exercise arenas available - a covered arena next to the building as well as another fenced in ring next to that.

**Crating:** Crating in the main building and the annex building is restricted to registered volunteer workers with printed volunteer crating permit. To register as a volunteer worker, see link in Volunteer section.

We were able to secure the stalls in two barn buildings just outside the main arena (30ft from main building rear doors) The stalls are covered and provide plenty of air-flow, even in hot weather. The sides of the barns can be closed should the weather conditions require this. Each stall is 10' x 10', enclosed with electric hookups and nearby access to water and restrooms. The stalls are numbered and can be shared. Stalls must be booked in advance for either 4 day or 3 day rentals. **Parking:** Loading and unloading ONLY in front of main entrance. Do not leave your vehicle unattended in the loading and unloading area. No Parking in this area. All vehicles, trailers, vans and RV's must be parked in designated areas; vehicles not in compliance with parking rules will be towed away at owner's expense. Take 295 to Exit 11B onto 322 West. Take the last exit before the bridge onto Rt. 130 South. Gloucester County Dream Park will be approximately 1 mile on the right. **Alternate:** Follow I-295 South to exit 10 (Center Square Road/ Swedesboro). Turn right onto Center Square Road. Travel app. 1 mile, turn right on Pedricktown Road (first four way intersection). Follow Pedricktown Road until you reach the dead end at the Stop sign.
