### Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs measuring 22" or less must be measured to validate their entry in an event and class in accordance with Official USDAA Rules & Regulations, unless:

- they have had their height permanently certified pursuant to USDAA rules and regulations (Appendix D) measurement rules
- they meet exceptions set forth in USDAA Tournament Rules for advanced rounds.
- hold a dog's temporary card or record with 3 judges' signatures as set forth in the regulations for dogs prior to 3 years of age

**A dog's height of entry may be challenged at any time though out the event.**

Please note that only dogs 15 months of age may be officially measured and recorded on temporary registration cards/forms. Dogs competing in Intro classes less than 15 months of age should be measured for the event, but the measurement shall not be officially recorded.

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## Cynosport Schooling/Practice Ring

A schooling/practice ring will be provided starting at 12:00 noon Wednesday, and continue through 12:00 noon Sunday for those wishing to purchase access. Cost is \$50 per handler for their entered dogs. Obstacles will be preset each day by a judge and are to remain in that position for the entire day. Wristband may be purchased on the entry form or at the event. *There is no proration of fees when purchased at or during the event.*

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## Class Descriptions

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### USDAA Dog Agility Classic (Warm-up Class)

Kick off the 40th Anniversary Celebration with this special warm-up class. The course will be a standard agility course from the archives dating back to November 1986. Winners are to be medaled with Cynosport Dog Agility Classic medals commemorating 40 years of dog agility in North America.

### 2027 World Team Selection Classes for IFCS World Championships

Competitors will earn points towards a "win-on spot" for the 2027 USA World Team. Point levels required to win a slot will be announced prior to the start of the event.

To earn points, competitors must be jumping the IFCS jump height as required in the Team USA Selection Rules published on [usdaa.com](http://usdaa.com). (Note that height cutoffs are different than USDAA regular height standards.)

Points are earned in the following classes:

- The four individual classes from the Team tournament
- Masters Challenge Biathlon Overall
- Additional round(s) (no entry fee) in Masters Challenge Standard Agility and/or Jumpers (open to top placement winners in Biathlon & those applying for consideration for Team USA who are running at their IFCS competition heights as set forth in the Team USA Selection rules. (Class(es) to be scheduled once Cynosport Entries close.)

Top competitors with the most points through the weekend will have first right of refusal to participate in the 2027 IFCS World Agility Championships to be held in Italy, April 27 - May 2, 2027.

Competitors not earning a win-on spot may still earn a spot through regular selection procedures as set forth on [USDAA.com](http://USDAA.com).

### Collegiate & Junior Handler Showcase

Showcase features participation by collegiate handlers (22 years of age and under who are full-time college students) and junior handlers (18 years of age and younger) in this showcase with a dog entered in the event. The showcase will be run on the Steeplechase finals course on Saturday. Any competitor advancing to and competing in the Steeplechase finals with any dog is not eligible to run in the Showcase.

There is no entry fee for the showcase; competitor must be entered in the event. A participation form must be submitted to the secretary either with their event entry or upon check-in.

Competitors are encouraged to wear this year's Cynosport® event T-shirt with black pants/shorts.

### Veterans All-Around & Showcase

*Dogs entered in Veterans may not be entered in other tournaments at this event.*

The Veterans All-Around is an individual competition that will utilize the Team class courses and scoring. The award winners are determined by their standing in the four All-Around classes, who shall in turn run in a showcase prior to the Grand Prix finals on Sunday to promote keeping dogs healthy and active as they enter later years in life.

- **Eligibility:** This event is open to all prior competitors in ANY TOURNAMENT (GP/PGP, Team/PVP, STP/PSJ, Biathlon) having competed at a previous Cynosport® championship event who have now attained the age of eight (8) as of the event date and who are not entered in any other tournament at this Event.
- **Advancement :** Based upon the sum of the scores from the four classes - Standard, Jumpers, Gamblers and Snooker - the top three competitors in each jump height will run in the Veterans Showcase that will be held on Sunday prior to Grand Prix Finals.

#### AWARDS:

1st through third place overall in the All-Around in each height class will receive a placement rosette and an award shirt to be worn in the Veterans Showcase.:

### General Tournament Regulations

The Cynosport World Games features the culmination of USDAA's annual tournament series. Tournament rules & regulations are published in their entirety on [www.usdaa.com](http://www.usdaa.com) and are incorporated here by reference. Excerpts are included here are not intended to deviate from the regulations and are included here for convenience, along with supplemental information. Should a difference in interpretation arise, the published regulations shall prevail.

Entry to the Cynosport® 2026 requires four tournament qualifications during the year, with at least one in two different tournaments. Two of the remaining tournament qualifications may be replaced by "5Q Wildcards" (i.e., 5 titling Qs in any level as defined in the tournament regulations.)

#### Dog Agility Masters® Tournament

- **Eligibility:**
  - Competitors are eligible to enter provided they have qualified for Cynosport in the current year.
  - All competitors compete in the individual classes for individual awards, and each competitor's scores are aggregated with their relay class for their 2-dog team or 3-dog team scores.
  - Team competitor raw scores from the Gamblers and Snooker rounds are aggregated to determine the Strategic Games Championship winners.
- **Advancement:**
  - The top 20 pairs entered in 2-dog team after the four individual rounds shall advance to the 2-dog Relay class to determine the Dog Agility Masters® 2-dog Team winners.
  - The top 20 teams entered in 3-dog team after the four individual rounds shall advance to the 3-dog Relay class to determine the Dog Agility Masters® 3-dog Team winners.

#### AWARDS:

- **Tournament Overall (for both 3-Dog and 2-Dog):**
  - Trophy & Tournament Champion Banner awarded to each member of the 1st place 3-Dog & 2-Dog Teams.
  - 1st - 3rd placements awarded rosettes, and Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals, respectively, for each team member
  - Cynosport® inscribed batons for each team member running in the finals.
- **Individual Class Awards (Standard, Jumpers, Snooker, Gamblers):**
  - 1st - 3rd Placement rosettes for the top 3 competitors in each jump height.
- **Individual Top Strategic Games Champion**
  - Cynosport® Gold Silver & Bronze medals with rosettes for 1st through 3rd places
  - Trophy cup & Tournament Champion Banner awarded to 1st place winners based upon top combined raw scores from Gamblers and Snooker in each jump height.

#### Masters Challenge Biathlon<sup>SM</sup>

- **Eligibility:** Competitors are eligible to enter provided they have qualified for Cynosport® in the current year.
- **Advancement:** This tournament contains two parts - a Jumpers and Standard round. Competitors may run in both rounds of the Biathlon, regardless of scores or faults earned in each.
- **Special Scoring Rule:** Pursuant to tournament regulations, a wrong course infraction in the Biathlon tournament classes shall be scored as 20 faults per occurrence rather than as Elimination. Penalties for refusals (including runouts) are assessed without limitation (i.e., 3 refusal penalties is not elimination; 5 points are assessed for each refusal incurred without limitation)

#### AWARDS:

- **Overall:**
  - Trophy & Tournament Champion Banner awarded to 1st place in each jump height.
  - 1st - 3rd placement winners: Placement rosettes, and Cynosport® Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals, respectively

NO QUALIFYING SCORES ARE EARNED IN THIS TOURNAMENT AT THIS EVENT

#### Steeplechase QUARTERFINALS:

- **Eligibility:** Competitors are eligible to enter the Quarterfinals provided they have qualified for Cynosport in the current year.
- **Advancement:** Competitors scoring within 15% of the average of the top three scores in the Quarterfinals in their jump height class shall advance to the Semifinals.

#### Steeplechase SEMIFINALS:

- **Eligibility:** Competitors may enter Semifinals who have earned a bye at a Regional Championship in the current tournament season. If that does not apply, advancement from the Quarterfinals is required.
- **Advancement:** Competitors scoring within 15% of the average of the top three scores in the Semifinals in their jump height class shall advance to the Finals, subject to a Finals class size limit of twenty (20) per height. A minimum of six (6) Semifinalists in each jump height will advance to the Finals, provided there are six competitors with scores (i.e., no eliminations) in the Semifinals.

#### Steeplechase FINALS:

- **Eligibility:** Advancement from Semifinals is required.
- **Finals Running Order:**
  - SMALL: Performance 4", Performance 8", Championship 8", Championship 12"
  - MEDIUM: Performance 12", Championship 16"
  - LARGE: Performance 16", Championship 20"
  - EXTRA-LARGE: Performance 20", Championship 24"

#### Steeplechase AWARDS:

- **Semifinals:** Competitors running in the semifinals will receive a Semifinalist lapel pin.
- **Finals:**
  - Each finalist will be awarded a branded jersey or polo shirt. Competitors should plan to have black pants/shorts to wear with the jersey or polo shirt in the finals.
  - Prize money of \$12,000 will be allocated among all jump height classes under a 3:2:1 ratio (\$600, \$400, \$200) allocation for 1st through 3rd places, respectively.
  - 1st Place Winner in each height class is awarded a Tournament Champion Banner.
  - Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals and placement rosettes awarded to 1st through 3rd places, respectively.
  - Finalists not in the top 3 placements are awarded Finalist Rosettes.

### Purina® Pro Plan® Grand Prix of Dog Agility® World Championship

NO QUALIFYING SCORES ARE EARNED IN THIS TOURNAMENT AT THIS EVENT

#### QUARTERFINALS:

- **Eligibility:** Competitors are eligible to enter the Quarterfinals provided they have qualified for Cynosport® in the current year.
- **Advancement:** Competitors earning zero faults and placing in the top 50% of their jump height in the Quarterfinals at this event shall advance to the Semifinals.

*Top 50% example: 31 dogs running in 10"; 15 are eligible to advance to the semifinals provided they have zero faults. If only 12 of the 31 dogs have zero faults, 12 dogs advance; if 19 of the 31 dogs have zero faults, only 15 will advance to the Semifinals.*

## SEMIFINALS:

- **Eligibility:** Competitors may enter Semifinals who have earned a bye at a Regional Championship in the current tournament season, or met the 3-First-Place requirement in the tournament season. If neither apply, advancement from the Quarterfinals is required.
- **Advancement:** A zero-fault round in the Semifinals with a time equal to or less than the Maximum Qualifying Time (MQT) calculated for each jump height is required to advance, subject to a Finals class size limit of twenty (20) per jump height. The MQT will be determined by averaging the top three times from no-fault rounds in the Semifinals and multiplying by 1.25. A minimum of six (6) Semifinalists in each jump height will advance to the Finals, provided they have zero faults, regardless of the MQT.

*MQT calculation example: The top three zero-fault round times in the 16" class are 33.25, 34.78, 35.10 / 3, yields the average score of 34.376, multiplied by 1.25 = 42.97 seconds (the "MQT").*

## Grand Prix FINALS:

- **Eligibility:** Advancement from Semifinals is required, or a First Place Regional Champion Super Bye as noted in the the current Tournament rules.
- **Finals Running Order:**
  - SMALL: Performance 4", Performance 8" Championship 8", Championship 12"
  - MEDIUM: Performance 12", Championship 16"
  - LARGE: Performance 16", Championship 20"
  - EXTRA-LARGE: Performance 20", Championship 24"

## Grand Prix AWARDS:

- **Semifinals:** Competitors running in the semifinals will receive a Semifinalist lapel pin.
- **Finals:**
  - Each finalist will be awarded an event-branded jersey or polo shirt. Competitors should plan to have black pants/shorts to wear with the polo in the finals.
  - 1st place winner in each height class is awarded a Trophy Cup and a Tournament Champion Banner.
  - 1st - 3rd place in each jump height: Placement rosettes, and Cynosport® Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals.
  - Finalist rosettes awarded to all other finalists.

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## Entries & Acceptance

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### Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

### NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

### General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA") and is open to all persons with dogs being at least 15 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered OR for Sanctioned Match), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, as amended as of the event date. A copy of the regulations and any any amendments may be viewed and printed online at [USDAA Rules & Regulations](#).

### General Refund Policy

Unless otherwise stated in a separate provision below, the Group or Club hosting this event ("Event Host") has no obligation to refund fees paid for entries withdrawn after the published entry closing date, whether due to being absent, dismissal from a class or the event as a result of disciplinary action, or for any other reason; nor shall there be any obligation to refund entry fees if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, weather, or other "acts of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the Event Host.

### Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

### 2-Dog & 3-Dog Team Entries

Team entries with incomplete information for team members (names and/or numbers) will be treated as draw entries. Team member substitutions will only be permitted prior to the start of the tournament. **Any substitutions are at the discretion of the show secretary.**

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## GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

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### Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of themselves, their dogs, children, and guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

### Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

### Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

### Bitches In Season Allowed

Special provisions are being made for competitors who have bitches in season (BIS). Any dog that is ill or exhausted and pregnant bitches cannot take part in the running of a class at competition. Our policies for this event are:

- A protective ground mat **MUST BE USED** at the start line in every ring, for the BIS to sit upon at the start of the run.
- Each competitor must provide a mat at each ring.
- Outside the ring, BIS's shall wear sanitary britches at all times when moving about the grounds at the event.
- Handlers are required to notify the trial secretary as soon as they know they will be running a BIS at the event.
- Handlers shall minimize the exposure of their BIS's to other dogs, and limit their movement about the show grounds.
- BIS shall be noted next to their name on the gate sheet for every class so that other competitors and ring crew are aware.
- BIS shall run in their assigned position in the running order.

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## Media Release & Rights of Privacy Waiver
